1.	Select your optimal storage location	
2.	Remove all food and liquid products	
3.	Thoroughly clean and disinfect interior	
4.	Clean out AC filters and vents	
5.	Store all clothing and linen away safely	
6.	Leave all cabinets and drawers slightly open	
7.	Close all windows, blinds and shades	
8.	Optional: Leave out baking soda or deodorizer	
9.	Seal any cracks or openings to prevent pests from entering	
10.	Remove any possible nesting materials from vehicle	
11.	Leave out pest deterrent (moth balls, sprays, traps, essential oils)	
12.	Fill your tank, add a stabilizer and run vehicle to distribute	
13.	Top up fluids (antifreeze, windshield, break and power steering)	
14.	Drain all waterlines, tanks, and inspect sinks, toilet and drains	
15.	Pump out remaining liquid (Use low psi RV blowout plug if needed)	
16.	Use antifreeze in sinks and drains	
17.	Remove battery from RV, inspect fluid levels, charge and store indoors	
18.	Remove all dry cell batteries from smaller devices	
19.	Thaw and clean refrigerator and freezer	
20.	Prop open appliance doors

21.	Switch off all gas appliances and turn off propane and butane at tank	
22.	Thoroughly clean RV Exterior and use a spray on wax	
23.	Use a UV protectant spray on seals and gaskets	
24.	Spray locks and hinges with lubricant	
25.	Inflate tires to recommended psi	
26.	Use jack to lift tires or place wooden blocks underneath (with chocks)	
27.	Raise or lower jacks on one end of RV to allow for water runoff	
28.	Put fitted covers on tires	
29.	Optional: Use a fitted RV cover	
30.	Inspect RV Monthly to exercise generator, rotate tires and brush off snow	
31.	Keep battery charged to around 80%
